## Statewide Services

ILCM provides immigration legal assistance to individuals of any nationality who qualify for services based on their income, case type, and residency in Minnesota. Examples of the types of cases we can help with include:

- \* Cases for victims of domestic violence and other crimes under the Violence Against Women Act and the Victims of Violence and Trafficking Protection Act (VAWA, U and T visa)
- \* Advice to Public Defenders
- \* Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) and DACA renewal
- \* Special Immigrant Juvenile Status (SIJS)
- \* Advocacy and Education
- \* Deportation Defense (including persons in Immigration and Customs Enforcement ICE custody)
- \* Citizenship and Naturalization applications
- \* Adjustment of status ("Green Card")
- \* Family reunification (refugees, immediate relative petitions, family-based petitioning)
- \* Adjustment of Status
- \* Cancellation of Removal
- \* Asylum and related applications
- \* Temporary Protected Status
- \* Appeals before the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA)

ILCM serves the community by providing a variety of programs and free legal services for the immigrant community. ILCM requests voluntary client donations to help support the services that we provide. Services will not be denied if no donation is made.

## Vulnerable Individuals

If you are a vulnerable individual (domestic violence victims, victims of trafficking, abused individuals) call (651) 641-1011 Monday - Friday, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm and identify yourself as being one of these cases.

## DACA

If you are eligible for Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA), please call and tell the receptionist you are a DREAMer.

## Service Provider

If you are a service provider and are calling on behalf of a client, you may contact ILCM directly by telephone, email, or fax during regular business hours (Monday - Friday, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm).
